

#### 26. Run and make a picture 3/4

Track 24

1 bar = 3 counts

Start: Partners US stand side by side – ft parallel– arms relaxed at sides Intro:4 bars

1-6 Stand ft parallel - arms relaxed at sides

7-12 Rise on demi pointe

1-12 Run DS on demi pointe free use of arms

1-12 Make a picture with partner and run away

1 couple dance at a time32 bars – enough music for 4 x couples to dance

#### Direction

US to DS

### 27. Run and find a fondu 4/4

Track 25

1 bar = 4 counts

Start: Face DS – stand in a space anywhere in the studio – ft parallel – arms by sides – Dancers body

Intro: Synthesizer sound Rise en demi-pointe

1–16 Run en demi-pointe anywhere in room -both arms swinging across front of body - sway freely with arms as though being blown by the wind

Wood block sound: Stop – face DS – 1<sup>st</sup> pos ft – arms at sides

- 1–8 Dancers Body inc Dancers belts
- 1-8 Melt slowly into fondu on LL with RF dégagé devant
- 1-16 Repeat run en demi-pointe
- 1-8 Repeat Dancers Body
- 1-8 Melt slowly into fondu on RL with LF dégagé devant

Close in 1st pos ft at end of music

#### RHYTHM and PERCUSSION

An introduction to a piece of music sets the speed ie the tempo of the piece of the music which is to follow.

A musical introduction is helpful to a dancer so that he or she knows what speed the movements will be performed.

It is important that the dancer, just like the musician in a band or orchestra keeps to the speed of the music.

Teacher to use a verbal introduction to set the speed for the rhythm games.

#### 28. The Introduction Game

Children and teacher stand in a circle

Verbal introduction by teacher to set the tempo

Teacher - Ready steady let's start

Child on L of teacher claps 123 saying aloud at the same time

'My name is --- 'on count 4 open hands palms up & say name aloud

The game continues anticlockwise round the circle one at a time

No pausing or stopping after a name

Aim to maintain a steady rhythm & even tempo as set by the verbal introduction

### 29. Altogether clap 1234

Start: Stand or sit in a circle

Verbal introduction – Teacher – Ready steady let's start

Altogether - 4 claps counting aloud 1 2 3 4

Repeat until teacher stops

### Teacher claps 123 - children clap on 4

Teacher counts & claps 1 2 3

Children count & clap on 4

Repeat until teacher stops
